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FIFA WORLD CUP 2026™ MIAMI HOST COMMITTEE UNVEILS TWO LEGACY ART INSTALLATIONS CELEBRATING YOUTH, COMMUNITY, AND THE POWER OF SOCCER

“One Game. One Youth.” and “One Game. One Community.” art installations bring art, culture, and the spirit of the beautiful game to Miami neighborhoods during the FIFA World Cup 2026™

MIAMI, FL (June 18, 2026) — The FIFA World Cup 2026™ Miami Host Committee unveiled two new community legacy art installations as part of its ONE GAME ONE PASSION Community Initiatives, celebrating the transformative power of soccer to inspire youth, unite communities, and create lasting connections across Miami.

The unveiling included two signature public art experiences: “**One Game. One Youth.**” located at **StorageMart** in Brickell and “**One Game. One Community.**” located at **MLK Plaza at the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Metrorail Station.**

These large-scale legacy art installations were created through a collaboration between the Miami Host Committee and Street Art for Mankind as part of the **#OneGameOnePassion** art series, with support from community partners and Miami-Dade County.

“These legacy art installations represent exactly what the FIFA World Cup is meant to leave behind — a meaningful, lasting impact that extends far beyond the matches themselves. They reflect the heart, culture, and diversity that make Miami so unique, while showcasing the power of soccer to unite communities, inspire future generations, and create connections that will endure long after the final whistle,” said **Rodney Barreto, Co-Chair of the FIFA World Cup 2026™ Miami Host Committee.**

“Art is a universal language, and just like sports, it brings people together. We are grateful to create these large-scale public art pieces in the city where it all started for us, as Miami welcomes the world during the FIFA World Cup 2026™,” said **Audrey and Thibault Decker, co-founders of Street Art for Mankind.**

Celebrating the Next Generation Through “One Game. One Youth.”

The “One Game. One Youth.” mural celebrates youth empowerment, opportunity, and the ability of sport to inspire confidence and ambition among young people.

Spanning approximately 16,800 square feet, the art installation was created by internationally recognized artist **Dragon76** and curated by **Street Art for Mankind**. The artwork depicts four young soccer players from diverse backgrounds competing in a futuristic soccer match, representing the energy, dreams, and resilience of the next generation.

Through a dynamic manga-inspired artistic style, the art piece blends themes of sport, innovation, and possibility, reinforcing the message that soccer can be a powerful force for connection and personal growth. The artwork was made possible through the support of StorageMart.

"Storage buildings are not what people might first think. We see them as community assets, and partnering with this mural project for the World Cup is exactly the kind of investment in Miami that reflects what StorageMart is all about." said **Adam Steckler, Chief Operating Officer, StorageMart**.

Celebrating Connection and Culture Through “One Game. One Community.”

The “One Game. One Community.” legacy art installation highlights the role of soccer as a universal language that brings people together and strengthens communities.

Created by Miami-based artist **Nate Dee** and curated by Street Art for Mankind, the outdoor art piece features four athletes representing diverse backgrounds and cultures, incorporating elements inspired by Miami’s Brownsville community.

The artwork includes references to local heritage, including the **historic Hampton House** and cultural patterns inspired by the **Marshall L. Davis Sr. African Heritage Cultural Arts Center**.

The installation also incorporates symbols representing countries competing in Miami during the FIFA World Cup 2026™, celebrating the global connection created through the beautiful game.

The blue heart featured on the soccer ball recognizes the **Blue Heart Campaign against human trafficking** and reflects the Miami Host Committee’s commitment to using soccer as a platform to raise awareness and inspire action.

Located at **MLK Plaza**, the installation also serves as a meaningful visual landmark at one of Miami-Dade County’s key transportation hubs, connecting residents and visitors traveling to and from tournament activities throughout Miami’s seven FIFA World Cup 2026™ matches.

“Nate Dee’s original artwork reflects the spirit of connection, community, and opportunity that defines Miami-Dade County. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Plaza

Metrorail Station serves as an important transportation hub throughout the World Cup, helping us move thousands of fans to and from the stadium during the tournament. We are proud to have a local artist bring his vision to life at our station. This legacy art project in historic Brownsville is a lasting reminder of how global events can create meaningful and lasting benefits for the communities we serve,” said **Stacy L. Miller, Director and CEO of the Miami-Dade County Department of Transportation and Public Works.**
